Terms and Conditions of Entry

Summary of Dates and changes for 2025

9th October Entry Deadline

29th October Hanging in from 6.30-8.30

30th October Preview Evening 7-9pm

31st October- 2nd November Exhibition Open to Public

2nd November Collection of unsold items from 5pm (One hour after the exhibition closes!)

This year we **still** have the large painting parameters £8 covers paintings over **70cm** with a **new** category of **extra** large for paintings over **1m**, other fees remain the same.

Like last year we will not be sending PAPER flier packs and preview invites, these will be just be digital.

There is now a Google form application option, but we are still accepting paper forms this year.

Location

Harpenden Trust Centre, 90 Southdown Rd, Harpenden AL5 1PS

Some parking available on the street or large Co-op carpark (Do NOT park in the pub carpark opposite)

Membership

You need to be a paid-up member of Harpenden Art Club to enter this exhibition. We welcome all, but ask that you pay our annual subscription of £25 (£20 for HVAF members) see hanging fee on submission form. This will then also gain you entry to our whole programme including demonstrations, life drawing and practical sessions. Plus free entry into our rolling exhibitions at The EMC, The Harpenden Dental Centre and the HAC Art on the Common tent.

2D Hung Artwork

- You may submit up to 6 original works for hanging (only one of which can be 70cm or over inc frame)(higher hanging fees apply see 'Fees, Pricing and Commision' these works will be accepted if we can accommodate them)
- Digital artworks are acceptable if you have altered and manipulated the image yourself
- One artwork can be 'not for sale' (write NFS in place of price) please note that these could be excluded if we are unable to fit all items into the exhibition (see note in 'Insurance & Legal' paragraph)
- Artworks must not have been previously exhibited at the Harpenden Art Club Annual exhibition
- All artworks should be labelled clearly on the REVERSE with **Artist Name, Artwork Title, Medium, Price**
- **NO** front labels please, we will produce these
- Each work submitted must have a unique name therefore if you have multiple items of the same subject please use an additional numbering system ie 'Sunflowers I' 'Sunflowers II'
- All work should be ready for hanging with a suitable hanging cord, using taped D rings placed 1/3 of the way down
(NO SCREW-IN EYELETS, CLIP FRAMES OR METAL HANGING HOOK / EYELETS)
We have a separate picture hanging guide, please ask for it if you are unsure. We cannot accept pictures which are unsuitable for hanging.

3D Free Standing Artwork

- Makers of 3D artwork (Sculpture, ceramics) may submit up to 6 pieces
- All works must be able to stand securely and be individually labelled for identification
- Only individually unique artworks are accepted as opposed to multiple crafted items (please check with organisers if you are unsure)

Browser (unframed) Artwork

- You may submit up to 6 artworks for the browsers
- Each piece must be ORIGINAL handmade art, NOT a reproduction print of your work
- They must be cellophane wrapped and include a stiffening board (No stretched canvases on stretcher bars)
- All should be labelled clearly on the REVERSE with **Artist Name, Artwork Title, Medium, Price**
- Each work submitted must have a unique name therefore if you have multiple items of the same subject please use an additional numbering system ie 'Sunflowers I' 'Sunflowers II'

Greetings Cards

- Artists may submit up to 30 greetings cards of their own art (handmade or reproduction)
- All must be a folded card with an appropriate-sized envelope
- Card and envelope should be fixed together either in a cellophane packet or with a sticker or band
- **EVERY** card must be labelled with the **Artist Name and Price**
- All cards must be the same price and the price should be a multiple of 50p (£1.50 min, £2, £2.50 etc)
- No multipacks or multi-buy offers
- Cards must arrive in a small box or suitable container with the artist name clearly on the outside (this is for storage, the cards will be displayed on the club's card racks) We will not use an artist's own rack

Fees, Pricing and Commission

- **Standard** hung work and 3D pieces £4 each, one **large** piece over 70cm (including frame) £8 **OR** one **Extra-Large** over 1m (including frame) £12, browser work £2 each (no additional charge for cards)
- Please use whole pounds when pricing your work
- Hung work should be a **minimum** of £50, browser work £15
- A commission of 20% on all sales will be retained by the club (plus an additional 1% for credit card purchases)

Handing In/Handing Back

- Handing in Wednesday 29th October (6.30 to 8.30pm) at Harpenden Trust Centre
- Handing back of unsold work Sunday 2nd November (5 to 6.30pm)
- To **avoid queues**, arrive **later** at both sessions
- **NOTE** there is an hour between the exhibition end and pick up because there are many jobs to complete, please vacate the exhibition if you are not one of the helpers
- A £5 storage fee could be charged for each artwork not collected at the allotted pick up time

Stewarding

- All exhibitors are required to help in the set up and/or stewarding of this exhibition
- Time slots will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis
- There is a time slot choice on the application form please give more than one option
- If you can give more help, please do offer. We are a fun and friendly team and all support is greatly appreciated
